- Arrive at Entrance 3 (Bristol Dragway Entrance), Highway 394. Take an immediate right turn. Medallion Campground will be your first campground on the left.
- Once the campground is open you may check-in 24 hours a day.

Overlooking the Speedway grounds and the Bristol Dragway entrance is a new benchmark of camping luxury featuring a private, exclusive "gated community" of 20' x 50' numbered reserved spaces with power, water and sewer hook-ups.

- If traffic permits during your arrival you are welcome to park in front of your campsite momentarily to unload your belongings before parking in the adjacent parking area.



CAMPGROUND PASSES

All camping and vehicle permits will be held at your camping check-in booth ready for you to pick up when you arrive. On arrival to your campground check-in booth you'll receive one RV pass and one Vehicle pass per campsite. All camping and vehicle passes must be applied on the driver side windshield and passenger side of the camper and remain visible for the duration of the event.

Printed on the permits you will find the designated section and site number that is reserved for you and we will be happy to help you find your site upon arrival.

ADDITIONAL VEHICLES

If your vehicle does not fit into your space or if you have additional vehicles to park, please see our staff at your check-in booth for more information about additional parking. No vehicles may be parked in an adjacent site as this may prevent another camper from checking into that site.

VIOLATION OF THIS POLICY WILL RESULT IN TOWING AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.





CAMPGROUND RULES & REGULATIONS

- Please visit or call your check-in booth for any camping questions, or to report any noise complaints or security concerns.
 - *See important numbers section for check-in booth phone numbers. (Dial 911 for Emergencies).
- Quiet hours are enforced between midnight—7AM. Please be responsible during posted quiet hours and respect your neighbors.
- No open fires (must be off the ground and in something you can put a lid on, ex—fire pit, barrel, etc.) BBQ grills/propane grills are permitted. Propane fill is not available on BMS property.
- Personal golf carts, ATVs, etc. are prohibited. Licensed street motorcycles are permitted with the proper motorcycle credential that is available at your campground check-in booth.
- External stereo or television speakers are permitted, provided the noise does not disturb other guests. DJs or live bands are not permitted unless used during a BMS sponsored event.

- Other prohibited items include fireworks, illegal drugs, weapons of any description, glass containers, drones/Aircraft of any kind, and other items that may pose a safety hazard or diminish the enjoyment of an event by other patrons.
- Vehicles and other camping belongings must remain and fit in your allotted site.
- Please place trash in appropriate receptacles and/or trash bags. Trash pick up times vary. Please keep trashcan accessible so that it can be emptied.
- BMS is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen property.
- Solicitation of any type is not permitted on BMS property. Sale of food, beverages, souvenirs or merchandise of any kind is not permitted.

CAMPGROUND RULES & REGULATIONS

- Generators are NOT permitted in hookup camping sections or our tent camping section.
- > PLEASE BE AWARE OF CARBON MONOXIDE DANGERS.

Carbon monoxide is a poisonous gas that you cannot see or smell, but fumes can be harmful or fatal.

Vehicle and generator exhaust MUST be expelled safely into roadways, not into adjacent campsites.

- Generators are permitted in all RV non-hookup camping areas.
- If exhaust/noise levels exceed a respectful level you will be asked to turn them off.
- Extensions are recommended on all generators.
- Violation of these rules may result in you being required to turn off/reposition



CAMPGROUND RULES & REGULATIONS

SHOWER HOUSE

Restroom and shower facilities are available for your use and are located at the Dragstrip Campground & Landing Campground. Shower house hours are as follows:

Sunday, September 11th – Monday, September 12th 10^{AM} – 10^{PM}
Tuesday, September 13th – Wednesday, September 14th 6^{AM} – 10^{PM}
Thursday, September 14th – Saturday, September 17th 6^{AM} – Midnight

PETS

You are allowed to bring your family pet(s) when visiting the campgrounds at BMS, however pets are not permitted in the grandstand areas during race events. To ensure safety and enjoyment of all guests and campers please abide by these policies:

- Please keep your pets leashed at all times when outside of your camper.
- If a dog is aggressive or causes disturbances you will be asked to kennel the dog.
- All dogs must be under the control and visual observation of their owner at all times.
- > Please clean up after your pet and properly dispose of the waste.
- Please do not walk your pet through another camper's site or allow them to relieve themselves on someone else's site.



SAFETY

For pedestrian safety and traffic patterns, post-race traffic will be prevented from exit from ALL of the camping areas until it is clear. Once that determination has been made, BMS personnel will allow campers/RVs/vehicles to exit. Please be advised that anyone who tampers with the bollards could jeopardize future renewal privileges.

POST EVENT TRAFFIC EXIT

(Thursday/ Friday/Saturday) vehicles will be unable to enter the property until traffic is clear. (Approximately 1 hour)

Please plan accordingly when leaving and returning to the camping areas.

Note: For a return ride, ADA shuttles will pick up those needing assistance at designated information booths at Gate 6 & Gate 17.









MEDALLION CAMPGROUND SHUTTLE

We are continuing our efforts to make improvements to the Medallion shuttle system that will work with the existing post-race traffic flow here at BMS. We will post updated information regarding the shuttles at the Medallion campground information board.

The Medallion golf cart shuttles will PICK-UP at the top of the ramp in Medallion and DROP-OFF at the walkway leading to Gate 13. Golf carts will also PICK-UP at this location during the day.





FOR POST RACE: Medallion golf cart shuttles will begin.

PICK-UP: Inside the entrance to Hospitality Village

DROP OFF: At the edge of Lot E, and PICK-UP again at the bottom of the ramp at the showers for service to Medallion.




BMS CAMPGROUND SHUTTLE & TRACKSIDE TRANSPORTATION
